Dear Landowners and Water users,

The District has been notified by the Bureau of Reclamation that 2024 has been determined to be a Shasta non-critical year. This year type provides the District a 100% water supply for this season. It was decided by the Board of Directors to set this year's rice water rate at \$80 per acre. Water applications are due by April 19th with the first quarter payment. Additional three payments will be billed in the following three months.

Staff will continue to measure at the field level, utilizing the Remote Tracker. This information is uploaded into a District database and will be available to you upon request. This measurement is mandated by the State in a continuing effort to increase efficiency and water use conservation.

As stated in our February letter, the District recently hired Derek Soeth as a Ditch tender. This year, Mike Niehues will transition from delivering water to full time District measurement efforts. Daniel Pride (530) 518-2322, will oversee water operations and will deliver water in the northern portion of the District (formerly Mike's area). Derek (530) 884-8700 will handle water deliveries in the southern portion of the District.

The District has recently sent a mass notification via our Regroup. This system can send messages via phone/text/email. Please contact the office if you did not receive this message with updated contact information.

As in prior years, during the spray season, you may drain your fields one time to spray. If you must drain a field more than one time, each additional refill will be billed another \$10 per acre charge. Please remember that if you drain your field while other growers are either still receiving an initial flood or are already receiving a reflood, there may be a short waiting period before additional water is available to meet your needs.

Your water application has been included for your convenience. Please return your completed application with your first payment to the office. If you have any questions regarding the applications, please feel free to call or stop by the district office. No water will be delivered until your application and first payment are received by the office. If you have any questions, please call the office.
